Pastoral Associate: Beginning July 1, T. J. Dennison will begin working part-time as a pastoral associate for St. Joseph and St. John Parishes. T. J. attended four and a half years in the seminary, has a great love for the Church and has a strong background in theology.

Some of his responsibilities will include: (1) assisting in the preparation and celebrations of the sacraments and weekend masses; leading communion services and other prayer services; assist the coordinators in the training of liturgical ministries. (2) plan adult education programs; assist in marriage preparation; serve as the director of our R.C.I.A. program; assist in the parish’s outreach to inactive Catholics. (3) provide pastoral support for individuals suffering from illness, grief, spiritual crisis; support ministry to our youth, elderly, married couples, singles, parents and families; (4) attend committee meetings; assist in the office; and assist in organizing the parish’s stewardship program.

There are about 21 parishes in our diocese that have permanent deacons helping out and about 18 parishes that have pastoral associates on their staffs. Our parishes will be blessed as T. J. Dennison begins July 1st working part-time as a pastoral associate.
